

HCC Patients Invited to Share Their Experiences for a Research Study

The Hepatitis B Foundation is pleased to partner with Flince Research+Design to identify patients with hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC or liver cancer) who are willing to share their story and medical journey that can positively impact the lives of fellow patients.

Purpose of Study:

To learn more about the HCC patient journey and to identify gaps in solutions and support for these individuals.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. HCC diagnosis that is unresectable (cannot be surgically removed)
2. Any person 21 years or older
3. Currently being treated with either of the two treatment approaches (or both is OK):
 - Loco Regional Therapy (LRT) - for example, TACE, TAE, Y90, RFA, etc.
 - Systemic Therapies – for example Nexavar (sorafenib) or other oral or intravenous chemotherapies

Study Activities:

- All participants will be asked to complete a 3-day diary (about 15-30 minutes per day for 3 days)
- This will be followed by a 2-hour phone interview, scheduled at a convenient time and date
- Participation is kept completely confidential

Compensation:

A **\$400 honorarium** will be provided to each participant for their time, which will be mailed after the phone interview is completed.
