

Hepatitis B (HBV) is one of the most common infections in the world.







Hepatitis B can infect anyone









Regions that have **limited access to HBV care** including **vaccines**, **testing** and **treatment** have **higher rates of HBV**

- People who are from sub-Saharan Africa, Asia or the Pacific Islands are at higher risk for HBV exposure
- More than 50% of people living with chronic hepatitis B are of Asian, Pacific Islander, or sub-Sahara African descent
