





The hepatitis B vaccine is a safe and effective vaccine that is recommended for all infants at birth, for children up to 18 years, for all adults, ages 19-59, and for adults age 60+ at high risk for hepatitis B.	The hepatitis B vaccine is also known as the first "anti-cancer" vaccine because it prevents hepatitis B, the leading cause of liver cancer worldwide. 
SYMPTOMS


