

Your Guide to Locating Hepatitis B Testing Resources

Testing to know your status is important! By being aware of resources available to help community members locate testing, you can help save lives. There are several ways to locate a place to get tested.

Locating a Doctor:

People can get tested for hepatitis B through their primary care provider. Ask the community member if they have a doctor that they feel comfortable asking for testing through.



Finding Lower Cost Testing Services

People can also get tested for a lower cost at Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). They are usually able to see patients for a low cost, or even for free. Please visit <https://findahealthcenter.hrsa.gov/> to locate an FQHC near the community member. It may also be helpful to call and better understand the services they provide.
