Preclinical

Exploring if and how a new drug may work

Phase 1

Exploring safety and dosing of the drug

Phase 2

Exploring the effectiveness of the drug

Phase 3

Exploring the safety and effectiveness compared to currently available treatments

FDA Review

To confirm safety and effectiveness of the drug

Phase 4

Evaluating the drug safety over time in real-life settings

Drug approved for human testing

Submit to FDA for approval

Drug is approved
